Rules & Regulations Check-In, Tee Times, Players and Player Risks

Updated: November 2018

Check-In

All players must check in at the Golf Shop before beginning play, regardless of how many holes being played.

Tee Times

Tee times are accepted for the Airport Golf Course and can be made seven days in advance. Tee times may be made in person or by telephone (637-6418 Airport Course, 307-637-6420 Prairie View Course) with priority given to those who register in person. Tee times can also be made online at airportgolfclub.com.

Green Fee Players

All players must register for play and pay green fees.

Punch Pass Players

All players must register for play and present a punch pass. Punch passes are non-refundable but are fully ransferable.

Annual Pass Players

All players must register for play and present an annual pass. Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable. Passes do not entitle holder priority in facility use or access. Passes do not entitle holder to play tournaments. A green fee is required for all tournaments that are not a function of the Airport Golf Club.

Player Risk

All users play at their own risk. The City of Cheyenne is not liable for injuries or damages caused by golfer activity or natural forces such as lightning, hail, wind, etc. In the event of lightning in the area, the Pro Shop staff will make every effort to inform players through the use of a blow horn. However, players shall assume responsibility for their own safety and seek appropriate shelter in the event of threatening weather.
