Rules & Regulations

Updated: June 16, 2020

Rec Swim Regulations:

- No one under the age of 16 years old is permitted in the facility without a supervising adult.
 - Maintain 6 feet social distance at all times.
 - 50 max capacity in building at one time.
 - Locker rooms will have a max capacity of 8 patrons at one time. We recommend coming prepared to swim and having over clothes to put on after your swim and shower at home.
 - Follow ALL CDC Social Distancing Recommendations while in the facility.
 - Limited showers are available at this time.
 - Limited locker availability. Lockers will be assigned at check in.
 - No public use equipment available at this time. Personal equipment is permitted. Life jackets will be available.
 - No rental towels available.
 - Please reserve your lap lane online at www.cheyennerec.org. This will help avoid lines and crowds at the front counter area.
 - Credit Card/Punch Card are preferred methods of payment.
 - Cabanas and Locker Rooms will be sanitized by staff before opening, during the hour breaks, and at closing.
 - NO GLASS ALLOWED IN FACILITY!
 - All standard posted pool rules, diving board rules, climbing wall rules, shallow water, and play feature rules will be adhered to.
- Remember the UNDER 8 RULE! Children under the age of 8 must be within arm's reach of an adult at all times, including in the water. A life jacket does not replace an adult.

Please note that rules and regulations may change frequently. The staff are working hard to keep everyone safe and we truly appreciate your flexibility and understanding during this time.
