The “Forgotten Objects” Photography Contest & Exhibit is designed to showcase an elapsed but cherished item that once shared countless memoirs.

Registration/Fees Info

Registration will be May 9 – August 25, 2022, at the Kiwanis Community House (4603 Lions Park Drive, 7:30a-4:30p, M-F).

All photos must be received (dropped off) on Tuesday, August 30, 2022, at the Cheyenne Civic Center (11a-5p).

Photos must be picked up at the Cheyenne Civic Center on Monday, October 3rd (11a-5p).

Entry fee of \$5 covers one (1) entry; a maximum of three (3) entries per person. Contest is limited to the first 150 photos submitted.

Youth entries: 1st photo will be free (limit of 15 free entries in the youth division). If a youth participant submits more than 1 photo, each photo after the 1st one will be \$5 (max of 3 photos).

Exhibit Dates

All photos will be on exhibit at the Cheyenne Civic Center, 510 West 20th Street, September 2 – September 30, 2022.

~A reception will be held the night of September 1st, for artists and their families. The reception will be from 5:30p-7p in the Cheyenne Civic Center lobby. Awards will be announced at the reception.

Rules

Photo image (excluding matting and/or framing) must be 5"x7" or larger, not to exceed 36"x48". Entry form must be secured to the back of each entry. Each entry must be wired from side to side and ready for hanging. Please review RULE NOTES for additional contest information.

***Accepting Canvas, Wood and Metal Prints.**

Photos should be as recent as possible (limit 5 years). Entries may be in color or black & white.

1. **Metal or plastic certificate frames and document holders may not be used.**
2. Glass or acrylic must cover the image and matting for protection (unless canvas/metal /wood print).
3. Please do not attach photo title to glass, matting or frame.
4. No writing/name/logo allowed on photos.
5. Please be sure to secure hanging wire to the frame. Tape, yarn, or other weak holding methods will not be accepted.
6. Entries must meet the required dimensions.

The City of Cheyenne, Cheyenne Civic Center, Employees, and Contest Judges are not responsible for entries damaged, lost or stolen.

The "Reflections" Photography Contest & Exhibit is limited to Laramie County residents only!

Sale of Photos

Should you be interested in selling your photo, please follow these guidelines:

- Photographer must fill out “For Sale” information on entry form.
- Buyer must submit payment to Cheyenne Civic Center (all transactions go through the Cheyenne Civic Center). The Cheyenne Civic Center will add applicable sales tax to asking price.
- A deduction of 15% will be made by the Cheyenne Civic Center on any photo sold. Photographer will then receive a check from the Event Coordinator (which can take up to 2-3 weeks).
